STREAM SYSTEM: Upper Putah Creek Watershed

Pope Valley Partners, c/o Royce W. Cunningham, Monticello Engineering, 825 Corte Malaga, Vacaville, CA 95688 has filed an application to appropriate water by permit. This application requires Watermaster clearance pursuant to Water Right Order 096-002. The re-notice has been issued because the Applicant failed to publish the notice in accordance with Section 1312 of the Water Code.

Amount:	10 cubic feet per second by direct diversion, with 150 acre-feet annual limit
Season:	March 15 through May 15 each year
Purpose of Use:	Frost protection
Place of Use:	263 acres within portions or all of Sections 16, 17, 20, and 21; all within T9N, R5W, MDB&M.
