Steven and Cecelia Tweed filed an application on November 16, 2009 to appropriate water by permit. This is a second notice. This application was originally noticed on May 6, 2010. On March 16, 2012, an Initial Study/Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration was circulated for public review and comment in accordance with the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act, which can be found at the following link:

As a result of comments received, the project has been modified to remove a proposed onstream reservoir and replace it with two interconnected storage tanks. The application is being re-noticed because the project has been changed since the original notice.
