The Applicants filed Application 31836 on June 29, 2010 and requested the diversion of 8.55 af. After a formal reservoir survey, conducted on June 26, 2011, the reservoir was found to have an actual capacity of 9.8 af. Application 32115 was subsequently filed to cover the additional 1.25 af volume to be stored in the same reservoir as Application 31836.

To comply with the State Water Board independent obligation to consider the effect of the proposed project on public trust resources and to protect those resources where feasible (National Audubon Society v. Superior Court (1983) 33 Cal.3d 419 [189 Cal.Rptr. 346, 658 P.2d 709]), Division staff has reviewed and evaluated environmental and public trust resource information for this project. Division staff has incorporated terms and conditions into the draft permit that: (1) avoid injury to any lawful user of water; (2) avoid and/or minimize effects to the environment and public trust resources; and (3) ensure consistency with the Water Code and the California Code of Regulations. Copies of the public trust resources evaluation and supporting documents are included in the project file and are available upon request.
