**NOTICE OF PETITION FOR CHANGE
PERMITS 11885, 11886 AND 11887
(APPLICATIONS 234, 1465 AND 5638)**

COUNTIES: Madera and Fresno STREAM SYSTEM: San Joaquin River

U.S. Bureau of Reclamation has filed petitions for change pursuant to California Water Code sections 1435 and 1707 for temporary urgent change to add fish and wildlife preservation and enhancement as a purpose of use, add points of diversion, add the stream channel as a place of use and to dedicate water for instream flow. Point of Diversion:	Friant Dam in NW ¼ of SW ¼ of Section 5, T11S, R21E, MDB&M
Amount:	3,000 cubic feet per second (cfs) by direct diversion and 500,000 acre-feet per annum (afa) by storage. Total direct diversion shall not exceed 6,500 cfs under Permits 11885, 11886 and 11887.
Season:	Direct diversion: February 1 to October 31 Storage: November 1 to August 1
Purpose of Use:	Present: Irrigation, Incidental Domestic Proposed: Add Fish and Wildlife Preservation and Enhancement

Place of Use:	<p>Present: Within gross area of 5,431,000 acres included as part of the area shown to be served by San Joaquin River water on Maps 214-212-37 and 214-208-3331, and also Map 1785-202-14 (Permit 11887 only).</p> <p>Proposed: Add fish and wildlife preservation and enhancement within: (a) the places of use depicted on maps 214-212-37 and 214-208-3331, and (b) the reach of the San Joaquin River place of use for dedication of instream flows as shown on map 1785-202-53.</p> <p>The points of re-diversion are listed on the scanned petitions on the Division of Water Rights web site. The points of re-diversion are located along the San Joaquin River downstream of Friant Dam to the federal and State pumping plants in the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta and also include San Luis Dam.</p>

Amount:	5,000 cubic feet per second (cfs) by direct diversion and 1,210,000 acre-feet per annum (afa) by storage. Total direct diversion shall not exceed 6,500 cfs under Permits 11885, 11886 and 11887.
Season:	Direct diversion: February 1 to October 31 Storage: November 1 to August 1
Purpose of Use:	Present: Municipal, Domestic, Irrigation and Recreational Proposed: Same as for Permit 11885.
Place of Use:	Present: Same as for Permit 11885. Proposed: Same changes as listed under Permit 11885.
