Dear Ms. Gaffney:

Enclosed with this letter are the Woodland-Davis Clean Water Agency's ("WDCWA") petitions for renewal of the March 28, 2016 order granting temporary urgency changes for WDCWA's above-referenced water right licenses and permit. The environmental information form for each petition and related documents are attached to the petition.

The temporary changes authorized by the March 2016 order expire September 24, 2016. As described in the petitions, WDCWA requests that the Division renew the March 2016 Order for an additional 180 days because the point of diversion authorized by WDCWA's rights is under construction and cannot be completed by September 24, 2016.

WDCWA would have to suspend all diversions of Sacramento River water on September 24, 2016 if these petitions are not granted. This would require the Cities of Woodland and Davis to revert to 100% groundwater supplies, which would not meet the current hexavalent chromium drinking water standard. Therefore, WDCWA requests the Division issue an order approving these petitions at the earliest opportunity.

WDCWA will separately submit a check for \$12,733.70, payable to the SWRCB Division of Water Rights, for the filing fees for these petitions. WDCWA will also separately

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submit a check for \$850, payable to the California Department of Fish and Wildlife, for the fee required by Public Resources Code section 10005.
