In that capacity I manage many aspects of PCWA's Middle Fork Project (MFP), including overseeing PCWA's hydroelectric energy and wholesale water sales under PCWA's water right permits and managing PCWA's regulatory and government affairs.

Because the operation of the MFP and Folsom Lake are critically linked in providing a reliable source of water for PCWA's wholesale water customers, parts of my

duties also include participating in matters related to the United States Bureau of Reclamation's (Reclamation) operation of Folsom Reservoir and the Lower American River. This includes issues related to Lower American River instream flow and temperature, Folsom Reservoir water storage and elevation levels and inflow, and outflow forecasting based on PCWA's unique knowledge of the North Fork American river watershed. I also work closely with Reclamation and the Sacramento area Water Forum staff to implement the flow, temperature, water conservation, habitat enhancement and supplemental water actions agreed to by all local water purveyors in the 2000 Water Forum Agreement.

I have reviewed and concur with the testimony of PCWA's General Manager, Einar Maisch. I am able to answer questions regarding PCWA's operation of the MFP, and issues related to PCWA's operation of the MFP as it relates to Folsom Reservoir and Reclamation's operation thereof.
