***Re: CWF Part 1B Proposed Groupings and order for Testimony and Cross Examination***


Dear Co-Chairs Doduc and Marcus:

This correspondence is submitted on behalf of Protestants South Delta Water Agency, Central Delta Water Agency, Lafayette Ranch, Heritage Lands, Mark Bachetti Farms, and Rudy Mussi Investments L.P. ("Central Delta Parties.")

The Central Delta Parties constituted its own group for Part 1A of the hearing and propose the same for Part 1B. As such, the Central Delta Parties propose that it be allowed to put on its case in chief as its own group and that our cross examination proceed in the same manner. The presentation of the Central Delta Parties' case in chief should not commence until after those interests representing export contractors, south of Delta users, and north of Delta water users have completed their respective cases in chief. The same is true for the Central Delta Parties cross examination. The Central Delta Parties also recommend that the hearing team afford maximum flexibility with regard to the coordination and availability of witnesses and that the proposed groupings and order of cross examination be distributed for comment before being finalized.
