Dear California WaterFix Hearing Staff:

On behalf of Protestant Sacramento Suburban Water District, I am submitting the enclosed protest and notice of intent to appear, which concern the Department of Water Resources' and the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation's water-right change petition for the California WaterFix Project. I previously have submitted protests and notices of intent to appear from the Cities of Folsom and Roseville and San Juan Water District, all of which also are clients of our firm.

As explained in the enclosed protest, Protestant previously has coordinated and collaborated with other North State Water Alliance (NSWA) parties in preparing and submitting detailed comments on the Bay-Delta Conservation Plan Draft EIR/EIS (DEIR/EIS) and the California WaterFix Recirculated DEIR/Supplemental DEIS (RDEIR/SDEIS). Protestant and the other above-referenced protestants that are our firm's clients similarly will be coordinating with the NSWA parties to present consolidated cases-in-chief during the SWRCB's hearing on certain common issues, including issues regarding whether the requested changes would operate to the injury of any legal user of the water involved and whether the requested changes would unreasonably affect fish and wildlife. Consistent with this approach, all of the above-referenced protestants and other NSWA parties have identified in their respective notices of intent to appear both witnesses who will be providing testimony to support their respective protests and witnesses who will be providing testimony on certain common issues.
