Subject: protect freshwater flows this spring and summer

Dear State Water Board,

I live in California and I care about the fish and wildlife of the San Francisco Estuary and I understand that the State Water Board has eliminated important freshwater flow protections for these species.

I urge the Board to:

1. Restore the freshwater flow requirements (in Board order D-1641) for March and ensure that these flows, which are critical to the continued existence of several fish species and the general health of our San Francisco Bay Estuary, are actually provided.
2. Reject new petitions seeking suspension of environmental protections for freshwater flows in March and April.

We need to have mandatory rationing of water across the state and encourage the use of alternative supplies such as greywater.
