I am hereby submitting to OAL and SWRCB the following arguments for consideration in connection with regulations regarding: Emergency Action Due to Insufficient Flow for Specific Fisheries in the Tributaries of the Russian River, title 23.

In my attempt to find out as much information about the May 14th meeting hosted by CDFW in Occidental, California, at the Salmon Creek School, that I was told occurred, but was never aware of, I was referred by Kyle Woolrich of the SWRCB to Andrew Hughan of the CDFW.
