## Gentlemen:

The purpose of this email is to clarify the scope of the hearing scheduled to commence on February 13, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. in the Byron Sher Auditorium. On November 28, 2016, the Office of Enforcement issued two enforcement actions against Deridere Aper Vinea, L.P. The Administrative Civil Liability Complaints alleged failure to file an annual water use report for 1) License 10708 (Application A021235) and 2) Permit 21219 (Application A030815). We received your timely filed request for a hearing and have determined that it is sufficient for both water rights. The State Water Board has received both parties notice of intent to appear (NOI) forms.

On January 4, 2017, the State Water Board issued a Notice of Public Hearing for February 13, 2017, on the Administrative Civil Liability Complaint for failure to file an annual water use report for License 10708 (Application A021235). The State Water Board will issue a Revised Notice of Public Hearing to clarify that the February 13 hearing will be to receive evidence relevant to **both** Administrative Civil Liability Complaint actions for License 10708 and Permit 21219.

In the alternative, Deridere Aper Vinea, L.P. may request that the hearing be rescheduled. A request to reschedule the hearing may be filed at any time before noon on Friday, January 27, 2017.

The State Water Board will interpret the existing, filed NOI forms to apply to both Administrative Civil Liability Complaint actions. If you would like, you are welcome to submit a revised NOI form by noon on Friday, January 27, 2017.
