SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR WITHDRAWAL OF ITEM FROM JANUARY 13, 2006
STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD MEETING AGENDA

This memorandum responds to your memorandum to Board Chair Tam Doduc dated January 6, 2006, requesting that the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) withdraw the item entitled, "Consideration of a proposed order following a hearing on draft cease and desist orders against the United States Bureau of Reclamation (USBR) and the California Department of Water Resources (DWR) and reconsideration of the Division Chief's approval of a water quality response plan for joint use of USBR's and DWR's points of diversion in the southern Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta" from the January 13, 2006 State Water Board meeting agenda and provide an additional four weeks before hearing the issue. This item was scheduled as Item 5 on the final January 13 Board agenda as revised on January 5, 2006.

Board meeting agenda Item 5 is hereby removed from the January 13, 2006 agenda and is scheduled for consideration at the State Water Board meeting on **Wednesday, February 1, 2006**. The Board Meeting will be held at 10:00 a.m. in the Coastal Hearing Room on the second floor of the Joe Serna/Cal-EPA Building at 1001 I Street, Sacramento. The deadline for submitting any written comments on this item to the State Water Board has also been extended to **noon on Tuesday, January 24, 2006**.

Each person will have a brief opportunity to comment on the proposed order at the State Water Board meeting. All presentations should be limited to five minutes. Comments should be limited to the general acceptability of the order or possible technical corrections. Parties may not introduce evidence at the Board meeting. Parties are encouraged to submit in writing any

comments or changes to the proposed order they would like the State Water Board to consider at the meeting. The State Water Board may not have sufficient opportunity to fully consider comments received after noon on January 24, 2006.
