<b>Conversation Summary</b>					
<p>I called and spoke with Stephen Peters in regards to his voicemail asking what the next steps are for his Application that has been canceled. Mr. Peters did not receive the letter giving him 30 days for reconsideration or the letter of the Order canceling his application. Aaron Miller emailed him pdf copies of both on 9/28/2010 which he did receive.</p> <p>During the phone conversation Mr. Peters said he doesn't understand why environmental studies need to be done, his frustration with the constant process, and would like a set list of items needed to be completed to obtain his water right permit. He also would like to know who in the past ten years has obtained a water rights permit in the Navarro watershed.</p> <p>I told Mr. Peters he may write a letter to the Division petitioning for reconsideration stating his causes. I also conveyed to Mr. Peters that filing a petition for reconsideration doesn't eliminate the potential for enforcement, and an application with the Division doesn't translate to a water right.</p>
