This letter is submitted by the Arrowhead Lake Association ("ALA") in response to Lake Arrowhead Community Services District's ("LACSD") letter dated October 11, 2005.

It is clear that procedural irregularities exist in this matter.

The problem identified by ALA was caused by LACSD and is made possible in part by the scheduling of the hearing on this matter. LACSD does not deny the existence of the problem, but insists that the schedule be maintained.

The 60-day extension requested by Mojave Water Agency is a very small amount of time and no one has identified any way in which this continuance would prejudice any party.

Mojave Water Agency's request should be granted – the hearing date should be continued for at least 60-days and the deadline to submit testimony and exhibits should be moved accordingly.
