Dear Hearing Officer Moore,

I am representing Klamath Riverkeeper in connection with the above-referenced upcoming SWRCB hearing, and I had an inquiry regarding scheduling. I was unclear whether this type of inquiry should be addressed just to you, or needs to be addressed to all the other parties to the hearing.

Klamath Riverkeeper is fine with the current November 13-15, 2017 dates for the hearing. However, I am a law professor at Golden Gate University School of Law in San Francisco where I teach 'California Environmental Law' and also 'Civil Procedure' on Mondays and Wednesdays (and cannot reschedule these classes). Under the circumstances, Klamath Riverkeeper and I would greatly appreciate it if it were possible to schedule Klamath Riverkeeper's presentation at the hearing for sometime on Tuesday, November 14, 2017 (a day when I don't teach) so that I can attend. We estimate that Klamath Riverkeeper's presentation will be about an hour, and assume there may be some follow up questions from the SWRCB or other parties in the hearing after the presentation.

Again, I was unclear whether this type of scheduling inquiry is something that needs to be cc'd to all parties, or can just be addressed to the SWRCB hearing officer or the other SWRCB's attorneys involved. I am fine with ccing the other parties on this request/inquiry if that seems appropriate, but just did not want to complicate things if this inquiry was something that could be handled without doing so.
