#### **Reminder of Time Limits**

The enclosure to the June 9, 2017 Notice of Public Hearing (Notice), INFORMATION CONCERNING APPEARANCE AT WATER RIGHT HEARINGS, specified the following time limits for parties (see pp. 5-6):

- Opening Statements: 20 minutes.
- <u>Direct Oral Testimony</u>: 20 minutes per witness per party and cumulative limit of 1 hour for all of a party's direct testimony. As parties must submit all direct evidence in writing prior to the hearing, oral testimony serves to highlight or explain the key points in the evidence already submitted.<sup>1</sup>
- ➤ <u>Cross-Examination</u>: Initial limit of 1 hour per party per witness or witness panel.

#### **Requests for Additional Time**

The hearing officers may, for good cause, approve a party's request for additional time to present direct testimony during the party's case-in-chief. For example, the hearing officers may allow additional time for the oral direct testimony of the witness if the witness is adverse to the party presenting the testimony and the hearing officers are satisfied that the party could not

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produce written direct testimony for the witness. The hearing officers also have discretion to allow additional time for cross-examination if there is good cause demonstrated in an offer of proof.

While several NOI's do not conform with the time limits specified in the Notice, these limits remain in force and effect. Any party wishing to request additional time for direct oral testimony must submit such a request, including a showing of good cause, by noon on July 25, 2017, the deadline for submittal of written testimony and exhibits.

#### **Reminder of Witness Designation Requirements**

Parties should designate each of their witnesses as either experts or non-experts. Expert witness qualifications must be submitted by the exhibit deadline of noon on July 25, 2017.

#### **Consolidation of Parties and Witness Panels**

The State Water Board encourages parties with common interests to work together to make the hearing process more efficient. We encourage parties to present consolidated or coordinated cases-in-chief to avoid redundancy, where appropriate. If a party presents multiple witnesses, the hearing officers may decide to have the party's witnesses cross-examined as a panel.

#### **Requests for Postponement**

By letter dated July 11, 2017, Barbara Brenner, attorney for Douglas and Heidi Cole and Marble Mountain Ranch, submitted a request to the hearing officer for postponement of the August 22-25, 2017 hearing until December or later. By letter dated July 11, 2017 to the hearing officer, Kenneth Petruzzelli, on behalf of the Prosecution Team, responded in support of a postponement of the hearing until September but not later than early November. By letter dated July 12, 2017 to the hearing officer, Barbara Brenner reiterated her request for postponement of the hearing.

Hearing Officer Steven Moore is currently considering the requests for postponement of the hearing.

#### **Ex Parte Communications**

I would like to remind the parties that *ex parte* communications with State Water Board members or staff that are not on the prosecution team are prohibited. Therefore, any communication concerning substantive or controversial procedural issues relevant to this hearing must be copied to all parties on the enclosed service list.
