The State Water Resources Control Board has postponed the Public Hearing to determine whether to issue a Cease and Desist Order and whether to impose Administrative Civil Liability against

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE

The Public Hearing scheduled to commence on October 14, 2016, and the submission deadline for exhibits and testimony of noon, September 14, 2016, as identified in the August 2, 2016 Notice of Public Hearing (Notice) are POSTPONED. The deadline for submission of Notice of Intent to Appear forms of noon, August 19, 2016, remains in effect. However, parties who submit a form by the noon, August 19, 2016 deadline will have an opportunity to submit a revised form in the future if and when the hearing is rescheduled.

On August 5, 2016, the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) received a joint request from the parties to postpone the hearing for 60 to 90 days. The Hearing Officers have granted this request. Further notification will be provided if and when the hearing is rescheduled.

<u>SETTLEMENTS</u>

In this water rights enforcement hearing, the prosecution team is prosecuting Mike Passalaqua and Peder Hoy for an alleged violation. The prosecution team, Mike Passalaqua, and Peder Hoy may, at their discretion, engage in private settlement discussions and may include other persons in those discussions. Due to the separation of functions, the hearing team cannot participate in settlement discussions.

Should the parties reach settlement, they must notify the hearing team as soon as possible. More information about settlements in water right enforcement hearings is provided in the section entitled "Settlements" in the Notice's enclosure entitled "Information Concerning Appearance at Water Right Hearings."

IF YOU HAVE ANY QUESTIONS

During the pendency of this proceeding, there shall be no ex parte communications regarding substantive or controversial procedural matters within the scope of the proceeding between State Water Board members or hearing team members and any of the other participants, including members of the prosecution team.
