**Description:**

At the request of Vicky Whitney (Division Chief) and Steve Herrera (Water Rights Permitting Section Chief), I telephoned Marty Kaiser (USBR), to determine the status of the groundwater recharge as a beneficial use for the applications and petitions for change (see above) to implement the Truckee River Operating Agreement (TROA).

Ms. Kaiser stated that the entire TROA group and their attorneys had met several weeks ago, and no determination had been made regarding the groundwater recharge. She understood that the group was leaning towards dropping the groundwater recharge as a beneficial use for this project. Ms. Kaiser also stated that a sub-committee would be meeting sometime during the first part of April 2005 and would make a decision by the end of April. Ms. Kaiser will inform us of any change in status.
