THIS IS TO CERTIFY, That **H. E. Day, Old Station, California**

of Water Resources of California of a right to the use of the waters of **But Creek in Butte County** as **made** proof to the satisfaction of the Division

tributary of **Fis River**

for the purpose of **Irrigation use** under Permit **2808**

of the Division of Water Resources and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of California, the rules and regulations of the Division of Water Resources and the terms of the said permit; that the priority of the right herein confirmed dates from

**July 15, 1925** that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to the amount actually beneficially used for said purposes and shall not exceed **one and twenty-five hundredths (1.25) cubic feet per second from about May 1st to about October 1st of each season.**

In case of rotation the equivalent of such continuous flow allowance for any thirty day period may be diverted in a shorter time if there be no interference with other vested rights.

The point of diversion of such water is located north eighty degrees twenty-four minutes west (N. 80°24'W) seventeen hundred eighty (1780) feet from the east-southeast corner of Section 32, T 35 N, R 5 E, M.D.B. & M. and being within the SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of said Section 32.

A description of the lands or the place where such water is put to beneficial use is as follows:

27.5 acres within the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 33, T 35 N, R 5 E, M.D.B. & M.  
12.5 " " " SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 33, T 35 N, R 5 E, M.D.B. & M.  
**40.0** " total.

All rights and privileges under this license including method of diversion, method of use and quantity of water diverted are subject to the continuing authority of the Division of Water Resources in accordance with law and in the interest of the public welfare to prevent waste, unreasonable use, unreasonable method of use or unreasonable method of diversion of said water.

Reports shall be filed promptly by licensee on appropriate forms which will be provided for the purpose from time to time by the Division of Water Resources.

The right to the diversion and use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the point of diversion herein specified and to the lands or place of use herein described.
