I am excited to see a proposed solution to the pending environmental disaster in my neighborhood that has the potential to turn the Sea and the area around. As you know the Salton Sea had been shrinking since the forced transfer of water to San Diego. Before that it was not in the best condition. Living next to it has not been easy.

The proposed Pipeline and exchanging water from the sea of Cortez is one that can do it. With the 230 foot drop from sea level the inflow can be done without pumps and some of energy can be harnessed to power the outflow. Since some water will evaporate it is possible that it would not need or need minimal pumps to return the salt laden sea water to the ocean. This would be a Green long term solution

In short I believe that the pipeline from the Sea of Cortez to the Salton Sea is a solution that needs to be seriously considered.
