I am John Maciel a resident of Tuolumne County and ratepayer of TUD. I support TUD having the flexibility to have a lower water level at Pinecrest Reservoir during the summer months. The Tuolumne County Watershed generates 5 million acre ft. of water and we are asking the state to honor an agreement with PGE for 20,000 acre ft. of water for TUD. Lowering the Pinecrest Reservoir by 2 additional feet will not have a significant effect on the recreational experience at Pinecrest Recreational Area. I am a retired Park Manager who has supervised a State Recreational Park Area, who had to always adjust Park activities to the water level because of state draw downs based on water delivery needs. The communities needs to have a stable water source without the yearly disruption and uncertainly of having water.
