I strongly urge you to reject this proposal. As a Quincy resident and avid flyfisherman, I am blessed with having the opportunity to enjoy both Lake Almanor and Butt Valley Reservoir. Both of these cold water fisheries should be protected. It seems the application of a Thermal Curtain at the cost of both lakes as cold water fisheries is unwise and unnecessary given the potential for rehabilitation of the stream environment upstream (Indian Valley, etc.).

Thank you for your time and consideration. I sincerely hope you will recognize the negative impact a Thermal Curtain would have on Plumas county and these two great fisheries and take all necessary steps to preserve and protect the same.
