Hello:

I am writing to urge you to adopt the proposed stronger protections for San Francisco's Bay-Delta Estuary. Adopting policy that allows rivers to flow more naturally is a vitally important step to sustaining and improving human and ecological health in California.

It's worth noting that other state and federal agencies, including the California Department of Fish and Wildlife, have recommended that half of the flow remain in the rivers of the San Joaquin Basin. This is a stronger standard than even the State Water Resources Control Board has proposed. I urge you to follow these recommendations and adopt policy that increases river flows and restores water quality.
