RESOLUTION NO. 69-4

COMMENDING THE

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, DIVISION OF HIGHWAYS
DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION
AND

U. S. NATIONAL PARK SERVICE
FOR CONSTRUCTING TRAILER AND CAMPER WASTE DISPOSAL FACILITIES

WHEREAS, the problem of improper disposal of camper and trailer waste was brought to the attention of the Board by a representative of the Humboldt-Del Norte County Health Department; and

WHEREAS, subsequently the problem was referred to the Water Quality Advisory Committee of the Board; and

WHEREAS, meetings were held with interested parties, both governmental and public; and

WHEREAS, this appears to be a public health problem with possible water quality implications; and

WHEREAS, the number of trailers and campers on the road is expected to increase; and

WHEREAS, facilities for trailer and camper waste are now being provided by the Department of Public Works, Division of Highways in new roadside rest areas and the Department of Parks and Recreation in new park areas and in some existing park areas and budget requests from both agencies provide for additional facilities; and

WHEREAS, the U. S. National Park Service is providing trailer and camper waste disposal facilities in national park areas within the State of California; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that this State Board commends both the Department of Public Works, Division of Highways, and Department of Parks and Recreation for having the foresight to construct facilities for trailer and camper waste disposal and encourages continuation of this program in new roadside rest areas and state park areas as the need is justified; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Board commends the U. S. National Park Service for constructing trailer and camper waste disposal facilities in national park areas within the State of California and encourages continuation of this program.
