STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 71-49

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR CHIEF, DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD AND THE REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, BERKELEY, TO CONDUCT A STUDY ON THE LONG-TERM EFFECTS OF TOXICANTS AND BIOSTIMULANTS ON THE WATERS OF CENTRAL SAN FRANCISCO BAY

WHEREAS, the current Toxicity-Biostimulation Study being sponsored by this Board has determined that toxicants from wastewaters affect biota in the San Francisco Bay estuary, and

WHEREAS, chlorination of wastewaters enhances at least the acute toxicity of municipal wastewaters, and

WHEREAS, additional study is needed to determine the long-term effects of chlorination and other wastewater components on higher aquatic life such as benthos and fishes, and

WHEREAS, this Board at its August 19, 1971, meeting approved this study in principle, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that this Board enter into agreement with the Regents of the University of California, Berkeley, for the conduct of this study during the period of August 1971, through June, 1972, at a cost not to exceed \$53,312 of Clean Water Bond Funds, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board's Executive Officer or Chief, Division of Administrative Services, is authorized to execute the agreement on behalf of the Board.
