## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 72-10

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR CHIEF, DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD AND THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA TO CONDUCT A STUDY OF DAIRY SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL

## WHEREAS:

- 1. The pollution from animal manure has been identified as a significant problem to water quality.
- 2. Completely satisfactory methods of manure disposal have not yet been developed.
- 3. These wastes are more concentrated and contain more fiber than human wastes. Therefore, they are not amenable to the same treatment processes.
- 4. On August 19, 1971, the Board authorized a \$15,000 study of the methods of disposal of animal manures in the Chino Valley. The dairy industry has agreed to support half of the project.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- That the Board enter into an agreement with the University of California for the conduct of this study during the period March 2, 1972, through June 30, 1973, at a cost not to exceed \$7,500 of Clean Water Bond funds.
- That the Board's Executive Officer or Chief, Division of Administrative Services, is authorized to execute the agreement on behalf of the Board.
