STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 72-16

RATIFYING THE ACTION OF THE CHIEF, DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, TO EXTEND INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT #260809 BETWEEN THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD AND THE DEPARTMENTS OF WATER RESOURCES AND FISH AND GAME FOR A STUDY OF TOXICITY AND BIOSTIMULATION IN SAN FRANCISCO BAY-DELTA WATERS

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Toxicity and Biostimulation Study was supposed to include a statistical reevaluation of the relative toxicity concept developed by Dr. Pearson in the U.C. Comprehensive Bay Study.
- 2. An expanded effort was proposed to include the validation of the basic data as planned and to combine some results of the Dispersion Capability Study with some of the results from the Toxicity and Biostimulation Study.
- 3. The extension required an addition to the funding of not more than \$25,000 and a time extension to August 31, 1972.
- 4. The Chief, Division of Administrative Services has acted to extend the agreement and add to the funding.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That this Board ratifies the action of the Chief, Division of Administrative Services, to extend the completion date of Interagency Agreement #260809 from October 31, 1971, to August 31, 1972, and increasing the maximum amount expendable from \$275,000 to \$300,000.
- 2. That the Board approves Amendment #1 to Interagency Agreement #260809 extending the completion date and augmenting the funding.
