RESOLUTION NO. 72-37

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR CHIEF, DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, TO EXECUTE AND ADMINISTER AN AGREEMENT FOR A STUDY TO DEVELOP THE GUIDELINES AND METHODOLOGY NECESSARY TO ASSESS IMPACT OF LOGGING PRACTICES ON THE AQUATIC ENVIRONMENT IN NORTH COASTAL CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Federal Environmental Protection Agency has allocated additional funds to support California's water quality control programs.
- 2. The regulation of water quality impacts of logging practices is becoming increasingly necessary and difficult.
- Proposals to conduct the work were received from four firms and evaluated by staff.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. The Board approve the contract as negotiated with Jones & Stokes Associates, Inc. for a study to develop the guidelines and methodology necessary to assess impact of logging practices on the aquatic environment in North Coastal California, at a cost not to exceed \$30,500 for the period June 15, 1972 to March 31, 1973.
- 2. That the Board's Executive Officer or Chief, Division of Administrative Services, is authorized to execute the contract on behalf of the Board.
