STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 72-47

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR CHIEF, DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY, SACRAMENTO, FOR A STUDY OF HEAVY METALS IN ESTUARINE MUDS

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State and Regional Boards need additional information on heavy metal concentrations in Bay muds subject to dredging;
- The investigation of actual problems will contribute significantly to the education of students in physical and biological sciences at California State University, Sacramento;
- The California State University, Sacramento, has excellent facilities for chemical analyses, including complex instrumental analyses;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That the Board enter into a contract with the California State University, Sacramento, for a study of heavy metals in estuarine muds in an amount not to exceed \$10,000.
- 2. That the Board's Executive Officer or Chief, Division of Administrative Services, is authorized to execute the contract on behalf of the Board for the term of July 6, 1972, through October 30, 1972.
