STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 72-48

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR CHIEF, DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD AND THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, AGRICULTURAL EXTENSION SERVICE, FOR A CONTINUATION OF THE STUDY OF MANURE HOLDING PONDS AND LAND DISPOSAL TECHNIQUES FOR EFFLUENT

WHEREAS:

- Waste disposal of manure from dairies has been identified as a significant potential problem for water quality control.
- 2. Studies have shown that manure holding ponds seal themselves in certain soil conditions.
- 3. Dairies are being planned in areas that have high water tables, and regional board staffs are unsure of the effectiveness of holding ponds in such areas.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- That this Board enter into a contract for continuation of the study of manure holding ponds and land disposal techniques for effluent by the University of California, Agricultural Extension Service.
- 2. That the Board's Executive Officer or Chief, Division of Administrative Services, be authorized to execute a contract for said study for the period July 6, 1972, through July 6, 1973, in an amount not to exceed \$1,500.
