STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 72-80

APPROVAL OF CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD CENTRAL COAST REGION ORDER NO. 72-52

WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR KAISER REFRACTORIES MOSS LANDING, MONTEREY COUNTY, CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS:

- 1. Order No. 72-52 of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Coast Region, contains waste discharge requirements for a discharge to ocean waters from Kaiser Refractories, Moss Landing.
- 2. The requirements do not contain effluent requirements for pH or turbidity as required by the Water Quality Control Plan for Ocean Waters.
- 3. Section D of Chapter VI of the Water Quality Control Plan for Ocean Waters provides, in part, that effluent quality requirements may be less restrictive if the discharge complies with water quality objectives in Chapter II and Table B, Chapter IV of the plan.
- 4. The discharge will comply with all water quality objectives in Chapter II and Table B, Chapter IV of the plan if it does not exceed the following effluent requirements:

a. pH -- 6.0 to 11.0 at all times

b. Turbidity -- no greater than 200 JTU at all times.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Order No. 72-52 of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Coast Region, is approved subject to regional board amendments to include effluent limits on pH of 6.0 to 11.0 at all times and limits on turbidity of no greater than 200 JTU at all times.
