

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD  
RESOLUTION NO. 76- 28

APPROVING ORDERS NOS. 76-58, 76-59, AND 76-60 OF  
THE CENTRAL VALLEY REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD

WHEREAS:

1. At its February 27, 1976, meeting, the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board adopted amendments to the Water Quality Control Plans, Sacramento River Basin, Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta Basin, and San Joaquin Basin, which will prohibit the discharge of waste from leaching or percolation systems in the following areas:
  - o Nice and Lucerne, Lake County
  - o Courtland Sanitation District, Sacramento County
  - o Six Mile Village, Calaveras County
2. These discharge prohibitions are reasonable and necessary in light of the evidence regarding the geologic conditions in the designated areas and the threat of contamination of surface and groundwaters.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board approves Orders Nos. 76-58, 76-59, and 76-60 of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board amending the Water Quality Control Plans, Sacramento River Basin, Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta Basin, and San Joaquin Basin.
