

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 76-61

APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 76-8 OF THE
CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY
CONTROL BOARD, SAN FRANCISCO BAY REGION,
AMENDING THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN,
SAN FRANCISCO BAY BASIN

WHEREAS:


1. At its May 4, 1976, meeting, the San Francisco Bay Regional Board adopted Resolution No. 76-8 which amends the Water Quality Control Plan, San Francisco Bay Basin as follows:
 - a. Changes the basis for complying with the Chipps Island chloride objective from a mean daily concentration to a 14-day running average of the mean daily concentration and specifies the location at which compliance with the objective is to be monitored.
 - b. Changes the conditions for complying with the Suisun Marsh salinity objective by requiring that the objective be maintained on a mean monthly, rather than a mean monthly at high tide, basis.
2. Such amendments satisfy State Board concerns regarding Suisun Marsh-Western Delta water quality objectives expressed during the Basin Plan approval.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board approves Resolution No. 76-8 of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region, amending the Water Quality Control Plan, San Francisco Bay Basin.
