RESOLUTION NO. 76-66

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT
WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA'S LAWRENCE
BERKELEY LABORATORY FOR ANALYSIS OF HEAVY METAL
CONCENTRATIONS IN SOUTH SAN FRANCISCO BAY

WHEREAS:


1. The San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board desires an investigation of the concentrations of heavy metals in South San Francisco Bay.
2. The University of California's Lawrence Berkeley Laboratory has submitted a proposal to conduct such an investigation of the seasonal and spatial variations in heavy metal concentrations.
3. The study will provide an understanding of the sources and fate of heavy metals in South San Francisco Bay.
4. Information provided by the study will allow an assessment of the effect of seasonal precipitation and runoff and the effect of low-flow, dry-year conditions on metal concentrations.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Executive Officer be authorized to negotiate and execute a contract with the University of California's Lawrence Berkeley Laboratory for analyses of heavy metal concentrations in South San Francisco Bay for a period of 5 calendar quarters ending December 1, 1977, for an amount not to exceed \$33,850.
