RESOLUTION NO. 76-77

APPROVING RESOLUTIONS NOS. 76-5 AND 76-6 OF THE  
LOS ANGELES REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD  
AMENDING THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLANS, SANTA  
CLARA RIVER BASIN (4A) AND LOS ANGELES RIVER BASIN (4B)

WHEREAS:

1. On April 26, 1976, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region, adopted Resolutions Nos. 76-5 and 76-6 which partially revised Chapters 2, 4, and 5 of the Basin Water Quality Control Plans for Basins 4A and 4B.
2. The amendments contained in Resolutions Nos. 76-5 and 76-6:
  - a. Add and/or delete beneficial use designations of various aquatic habitats for a number of the waters of the basin.
  - b. Make explicit the understandings that existing potential and intermittent beneficial uses are protected as required and that when two numerical values for the same water quality objective conflict, the more stringent will be enforced.
  - c. Bring the water quality objectives for turbidity and REC-2 bacteriological limits into conformance with uniform objectives suggested by the State Board.
  - d. State that the concentration of total chlorinated hydrocarbon pesticides shall not exceed 0.001 mg/l in waters designated Warm, Cold, Wild, or Rare.
  - e. Remove language limiting violations of pH and dissolved oxygen water quality objectives to waste discharges only.
  - f. Interpret numerical water quality objectives for TDS, Boron, Sulfate, Chloride, Sodium Equivalent Ratio, and Nitrogen (the latter two for surface waters only).
  - g. Make the public aware that lists of dischargers, municipal discharger rankings, analyses of significant dischargers, and compliance schedules for these same dischargers are available to the public in the Regional Board files.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board approves Resolution Nos. 76-5 and 76-6 of the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board amending Water Quality Control Plans, Santa Clara River Basin (4A) and Los Angeles River Basin (4B) except for the revisions to the pesticides objectives.
