RESOLUTION NO. 76-100

APPROVING ORDER NO. 76-129 OF THE CENTRAL VALLEY  
REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD AMENDING THE  
WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN, SACRAMENTO RIVER BASIN (5A)

WHEREAS:

1. At its May 28, 1976, meeting, the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board adopted an amendment to the Water Quality Control Plan, Sacramento River Basin (5A), which prohibits further installation of leaching and percolation systems within the Taylorsville County Service Area, Plumas County.
2. This prohibition is reasonable and necessary in light of the evidence regarding the geologic conditions in the designated area and the threat of contamination of surface waters.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board approve Order No. 76-129 of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board amending the Water Quality Control Plan, Sacramento River Basin.
