RESOLUTION NO. 80-76

ADOPTION OF PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE GUIDELINES
FOR SEWAGE DISPOSAL FROM LAND DEVELOPMENTS--
CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD,
COLORADO RIVER BASIN REGION

WHEREAS:


1. Subsurface waste discharges from individual treatment and disposal systems for land developments in the Colorado River Basin Region are governed by the Regional Board's Resolution No. 74-83 which was adopted in 1974.
2. Portions of these guidelines are in conflict with the guidelines for sewage disposal from land developments in the adjoining Regional Boards.
3. The Regional Board has proposed to modify the existing guidelines.
4. The Regional Board adopted a Negative Declaration for the project on March 14, 1979 pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act.
5. The Regional Board has coordinated preparation of these guidelines with the Santa Ana and Lahontan Regional Boards, the Riverside County Department of Health and the San Bernardino County Environmental Health Services Department.
6. State Board staff has reviewed the Guidelines and Negative Declaration, as well as Resolution No. 79-42 and is in general concurrence with the Regional Board.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. The State Board approves Resolution No. 79-42 of the Colorado River Basin Regional Water Quality Control Board (7), which adopts a Negative Declaration for the action of the Regional Board and adopts "Guidelines for Sewage Disposal from Land Developments."
