DESIGN OPTIMIZATION OF THE CHLORINATION PROCESS  
AND DECHLORINATION PRACTICES IN FULFILLMENT OF  
INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT NO. 58C400

WHEREAS:


1. In October 1975, the State Board executed Interagency Agreement No. 58C400 with the Department of Health Services (then the Department of Health) for a study of optimization of the chlorination process. The State Board obtained a federal Environmental Protection Agency research grant to fund most of the study.
2. The Department has completed the study and submitted the final report, "Design Optimization of the Chlorination Process", and a separate "Manual for Wastewater Chlorination and Dechlorination Practices".
3. The Environmental Protection Agency Project Officer has reviewed the final report and indicated it is acceptable for compliance with the Environmental Protection Agency's grant requirements.
4. The State Board staff have found the report and the manual acceptable.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board approves the final report and the manual in fulfillment of Interagency Agreement No. 58C400.
