AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF AN
INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF
FISH AND GAME FOR PERSONAL SERVICES

WHEREAS:


1. The State Water Resources Control Board requires assistance in developing and operating statewide surveillance and monitoring programs to comply with the Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act Amendments of 1972 and the Federal Clean Water Act (PL 92-500).
2. The Department of Fish and Game has provided personal services to the State Board in the past and is capable of and amenable to providing expert assistance during F.Y. 1981-82.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board's Executive Director is authorized to negotiate and execute an Interagency Agreement with the Department of Fish and Game for personal services of an individual acceptable to the State Board for the period July 1, 1981, through June 30, 1982, at a cost not to exceed \$55,000 in F.Y. 1981-82 Bond Fund monies, subject to approval of the proposed F.Y. 1981-82 budget.
