AUTHORIZING INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT NO. 0-083-180-0 BETWEEN THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD AND THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES (DWR) FOR A STUDY OF MINERAL INCREMENTS IN WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

WHEREAS:


1. The Water Quality Control Plan for the Santa Ana River Basin established a Mineral Source Control Program. Part of the Plan requires control of mineral increases during the use of water.
2. The Basin Plan documented increases in total dissolved solids content during water use.
3. A number of other mineral constituents are of concern within the Santa Ana River Basin.
4. This study would provide the necessary documentation of these mineral increases.
5. The Department of Water Resources is the appropriate agency to conduct this study and has agreed to undertake the project.
6. Costs for this study have been budgeted from the Bond Fund.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board's Executive Director, or any person delegated by the Executive Director, be authorized to approve Interagency Agreement No. 0-083-180-0 between the Board and the Department of Water Resources in an amount not to exceed \$53,000 of Bond Funds for a study of mineral increments in the Santa Ana Region.
