RESOLUTION NO. 81-35

ACCEPTANCE OF SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY REPORT "INDIVIDUAL
SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS AND ALTERNATIVES" AND CERTIFICA-
TION OF COMPLETION OF THEIR PHASE I 208 CONTRACT

WHEREAS:

1. The State Board is the responsible agency for conducting water quality management planning in the State's nondesignated 208 area pursuant to Section 208 of PL 92-500 and subsequent amendments.
2. A nondesignated area 208 workplan, approved by the State Board in March 1978, identified planning issues to be addressed, which included working with county governments to develop local water quality management plans.
3. San Bernardino County contracted with the State Board to prepare best management practices for individual wastewater disposal systems in the County.
4. The County completed a report of existing practices and determined that the existing system was the best management practice and no further work was needed.
5. Lahontan Regional Board agreed with this finding and adopted Resolution 80-4, which was amended by Resolution 81-1.
6. Funding for this contract was provided entirely by the Federal 208 program without requiring a State match.
7. The Board has reviewed the record, approves the staff recommendations, and finds that unexpended funds in the amount of \$22,860.95 should be reverted to EPA.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board:

1. Accepts San Bernardino County's "Phase III Report: Individual Wastewater Disposal Systems and Alternatives".
2. Certifies that San Bernardino County has completed its obligation under Phase I 208 contract with the State Board to study individual wastewater disposal systems.
3. Directs all unexpended funds be reverted to EPA.
