RESOLUTION NO. 85-8

AUTHORIZING GRANT INCREASES FOR FOUR (4) CITY  
AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO PROJECTS FOR THE PURPOSE  
OF COMPLETING PORTIONS OF THE SAN FRANCISCO  
WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEM

WHEREAS:

1. In 1973 the City and County of San Francisco developed a Master Plan to upgrade the level of sewage treatment from primary to secondary and to limit the number of direct discharges of untreated combined sewage (sewage and storm water).
2. During the 1985 priority list hearings, the State Board discussed and approved increases to existing grants as a strategy for funding approved portions of the City and County of the San Francisco Master Plan.
3. The State Board has a policy that requires Board approval of grant increases proposed by the Division of Clean Water Grants.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board approves the following grant increases to the City and County of San Francisco for the purpose of funding the indicated projects:

1. A \$2,250,000 increase in the Southeast WPC Plant Improvements Grant (C-06-1099-110) to fund the Digester Modification project;
2. A \$5,700,000 increase in the Channel Basin Consolidation of Outfalls Grant (C-06-1099-110) to fund the Channel and Northshore Outfall Tide Gates (C-5C) and the Division Street Sewer projects;
3. A \$10,575,000 increase in the Westside Storage and Transport Facilities Grant (C-06-1253-130) to fund the Westside Activation project;
