RESOLUTION NO. 86-2

AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT TO MASTER SERVICES INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD AND CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY FOR THE CONTRACTING OF STUDENT INTERNSHIPS FROM VARIOUS CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITIES

WHEREAS:

- 1. On September 1, 1985, the State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Water Rights, entered into a Master Services Interagency Agreement with California State Univerity (CSU Agreement) to hire and to provide on-the-job training to student interns.
- The CSU Agreement will be utilized for four project areas. The projects are: (1) the Bay-Delta hearings; (2) Investigation and Licensing Section; (3) Environmental Section; and (4) the San Joaquin River Basin model.
- 3. Workload in the Division of Water Rights has increased due to an increase in the number of court references, water right complaints, complex water applications and new special studies. Additional assistance is needed to perform the activities required by the Division. The student interns can perform those less technical, routine functions which will ultimately freeup our technical staff to do the most critical and important functions.
- 4. The Division of Water Rights requests a Master Services Interagency Agreement with California State University to hire and to provide training to student interns.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board authorize the Executive Director to negotiate and execute an amendment to the Master Services Interagency Agreement between the State Water Resources Control Board and the California State University for student assistance, augmenting the Agreement by not to exceed \$174,000, subject to appproval of funding.
