RESOLUTION NO. 86-7

APPROVAL TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT A SUPPLEMENTAL  
SECTION 106 GRANT TO CONTINUE DEVELOPMENT OF CALIFORNIA'S  
GROUND WATER QUALITY PROTECTION STRATEGY

WHEREAS:

1. The U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued a Ground Water Quality Protection Strategy dated August 1984.
2. This Strategy emphasizes the need for each state to develop a ground water quality protection strategy.
3. The Congress of the United States appropriated supplemental funds to EPA for allocation to states under Section 106 of the Clean Water Act to support development of State ground water quality protection strategies.
4. The State Board initiated development of a ground water quality protection strategy using Section 106 funds awarded to California during Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 1985.
5. Additional Section 106 ground water funding is available during FFY 1986.
6. The State Board has prepared a workplan for continuing the development of its ground water quality protection strategy utilizing supplemental Section 106 grant funds for FFY 1986.
7. The State Board considered and approved this workplan at its January 1986 Board meeting.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

1. Approves the supplemental Section 106 Workplan for FFY 1986 to continue development of a ground water quality protection strategy.
2. Authorizes the Executive Director to apply for and to accept the supplemental Section 106 grant from EPA.

3. Authorizes the Executive Director to execute contracts to implement the Workplan for Development of a ground water protection strategy.
