ACCEPTANCE OF ASSOCIATION OF BAY AREA GOVERNMENTS' 205(j) PHASE I FINAL REPORT AS COMPLETION OF THE "EVALUATION OF TOXIC HYDROCARBON DISHCARGES AND CONTROLS PROJECT"

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to the terms of a Phase I 205(j) grant from the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) provided funds to the Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) to conduct a study regarding the evaluation of toxic hydrocarbon discharges to San Francisco Bay and potential mitigating controls.
- 2. ABAG has completed and submitted to the State Board a final report for this project, entitled <u>Evaluation of Hydrocarbons in Runoff to San Francisco Bay</u>.
- 3. The State Board has found that the aforementioned final report conforms to the requirements of the EPA 205(j) Phase I grant workplan and to Contract No. 3-087-225-0, under which ABAG received funding.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

- Accepts the aforementioned final report as completion of Contract No. 3-087-225-0 under which the work was funded.
- Approves final payment to ABAG for work performed under Contract No. 3-087-225-0.
- 3. Strongly urges ABAG to seek implementation of the appropriate findings and recommendations of this 205(j) Water Quality Planning Project.



4. Directs staff to transmit the final report to EPA as completion of the ABAG Phase I 205(j) project entitled "Evaluation of Toxic Hydrocarbon Dischargers and Controls".
