AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT TO INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE  
STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD AND  
CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY FOR THE CONTRACTING OF  
STUDENT SERVICES FROM VARIOUS CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITIES

WHEREAS:


1. The State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Water Rights is entering into an Interagency Agreement with California State University (CSU Agreement) in the amount of \$60,000 to provide qualified student personnel.
2. The CSU Agreement will be utilized for five project areas. The project areas are: (1) Application Section; (2) the 1986 Bay-Delta Hearings; (3) Environmental Section; (4) Investigation and License Section; and (5) the San Joaquin River Basin Model.
3. Workload in the Division of Water Rights has increased due to an increase in the number of court references, water right complaints, complex water applications and new special studies. Additional assistance is needed to perform the activities required by the Division. Under close supervision, the students can perform those less technical and routine functions related to their fields of study.
4. The Division of Water Rights requests the Interagency Agreement with California State University be amended to increase the contract amount to \$150,000.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board authorize the Executive Director to negotiate and execute an amendment to the Interagency Agreement between the State Water Resources Control Board and the California State University for student services; the Agreement is not to exceed \$150,000, subject to approval of funding.
