RESOLUTION NO. 87-9

ACCEPTANCE OF INYO COUNTY'S PHASE I 205(j) FINAL REPORT  
AS COMPLETION OF THE "COOPERATIVE VEGETATION STUDY  
ELEMENT OF THE 'OWENS VALLEY GROUND WATER  
BASIN MANAGEMENT PLAN STUDY'"

WHEREAS:

1. Pursuant to the terms of a Phase I 205(j) grant from the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) provided funds under Standard Agreement No. 3-081-225-0 to Inyo County to conduct the "Cooperative Vegetation Study Element of the 'Owens Valley Ground Water Basin Management Plan Study'".
2. Inyo County has completed and submitted to the State Board a final report for the project, entitled Transpiration Processes of Shallow Groundwater Shrubs and Grasses in the Owens Valley, California. Included under the above title are three separate sections entitled Phase 1: Steady State Conditions; Phase 2: Soil Water Changes and Plant Responses Induced by Altered Depth to the Watertable; and Rooting Relationships.
3. The State Board has found that the aforementioned final report conforms to the requirements of the EPA Phase I 205(j) grant and to Standard Agreement No. 3-081-225-0 under which Inyo County performed the work.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:


That the State Board:

1. Accepts the aforementioned final report as completion of the Phase I 205(j) Project entitled "Cooperative Vegetation Study Element of the 'Owens Valley Ground Water Basin Management Plan Study'".
2. Authorizes final payment to Inyo County for work performed under Standard Agreement No. 3-081-225-0.

3. Directs staff to transmit the final report to EPA as completion of the Inyo County's Phase I 205(j) Project entitled "Cooperative Vegetation Study Element of the 'OwensValley Ground Water Basin Management Plan Study'".
