APPROVAL TO AWARD SUPPLEMENTAL STATE GRANT ASSISTANCE
TO THE CITY OF AVALON - CLEAN WATER GRANT NUMBER
C-06-0731-110

WHEREAS:

1. The Avalon Treatment Plant expansion project received an EPA grant in July 1987 for a total state eligible cost of \$1,487,080; and
2. The community of Avalon has a population less than 5,000 and total eligible project costs are under \$2.5 million; and
3. The State Board's Implementation Plan and Policy for the Clean Water Bond Law of 1984 provides that the amount of the supplemental grant be determined by using a formula contained in that document; and
4. The requested supplemental grant will not result in a combined federal and state assistance of more than 97.5 percent of the state eligible project cost.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

1. Has determined that the City of Avalon project is eligible to receive a supplemental state grant under the 1984 Clean Water Bond Law.
2. Approves the award of state supplemental grant assistance in the amount of \$228,395 to the City of Avalon.
