

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD  
RESOLUTION NO. 88-122

APPROVAL AN EXPENDITURE  
OF \$65,000 FROM THE  
WATER POLLUTION CLEANUP AND ABATEMENT ACCOUNT  
FOR UNDERGROUND TANK CLEANUP, FEATHER RIVER ROAD, YUBA COUNTY

WHEREAS:

1. The State Water Resources Control Board, after a noticed workshop and Board meeting has agreed to expend \$65,000 from the Water Pollution Cleanup and Abatement Account to pay the cost of removing underground tanks and for the cleanup of groundwater and soils contamination in the vicinity of Feather River Road and Broadway, Yuba County.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

1. Orders that the amount of \$65,000 from the Water Pollution Cleanup and Abatement Account be paid to Yuba County, to be used for the purposes specified in the recitals of this resolution, and subject to the conditions stated in this resolution.
2. No funds shall be paid until Yuba County submits to the Executive Director, in a form satisfactory to him, a work plan showing that Yuba County has committed at least \$35,000 in matching funds to be used for alternative water supplies and for activities in connection with the cleanup funded under this resolution. The work plan shall also describe how such matching funds will be used.
3. All unexpended funds shall automatically revert to the Water Pollution Cleanup and Abatement Account twelve months from the date of encumbrance, unless a time extension is granted by the Executive Director or designee.
4. Upon completion of the work funded under this resolution, Yuba County shall submit a report to the Office of Chief Counsel describing the work accomplished and discussing any possible recoupment of funds.
5. Any funds which are recouped shall be returned to the Water Pollution Cleanup and Abatement Account.
