STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 90-97

PRIORITY SYSTEM FOR THE STATE REVOLVING FUND (SRF) LOAN PROGRAM

WHEREAS:

- 1. The federal Clean Water Act was amended in 1987 creating the SRF Loan Program making nonpoint source, estuary, and storm drainage projects and programs eligible for assistance;
- 2. On April 4, 1990, the State Board adopted the Water Quality Assessment which identifies those water bodies which should be given top priority for cleanup;
- 3. The existing Priority System does not provide for funding of the other eligible projects and programs, and does not provide for coordination of funding with the adopted Water Quality Assessment; and
- 4. The Division of Clean Water Programs has proposed a new Priority System Policy which combines funding for all eligible projects and programs under a single Priority List and which coordinates project funding with the State Board's Water Quality Assessment.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

Approves the use of Policy in lieu of regulation and adopts the SRF Priority System Policy.
